RESOLUTION

Of inquiry requesting the President, and directing the Secretary of Health and Human Services, to transmit, respectively, certain information to the House of Representatives referring to the separation of children from their parents or guardians as a result of the President’s “zero tolerance” policy.

- 1 *Resolved*, That the President is requested, and the
- 2 Secretary of Health and Human Services is directed, to
- 3 transmit, respectively, to the House of Representatives,
- 4 not later than 14 days after the date of the adoption of
- 5 this resolution, copies of all documents, memoranda, advisory
- 6 legal opinions, notes from meetings, audio recordings,

1 records (including telephone and electronic mail records),
2 correspondence, and other communications, or any portion
3 of any such communications, to the extent that any such
4 one or more items are within the possession of the Presi-
5 dent or the Secretary, respectively, and refer to the fol-
6 lowing:

7 (1) The health and welfare of children forcibly
8 separated from their parents or guardians as a re-
9 sult of the President’s “zero tolerance” policy.

10 (2) The long-term implications of the Presi-
11 dent’s “zero tolerance” policy on the health of chil-
12 dren described in paragraph (1).

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
