## A BILL

To identify certain roads in the vicinity of Beale Air Force Base and Travis Air Force Base, California, as defense access roads for purposes of the Defense Access Road Program.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. IDENTIFICATION OF DEFENSE ACCESS ROADS,
- 4 BEALE AIR FORCE BASE AND TRAVIS AIR
- 5 FORCE BASE, CALIFORNIA.
- 6 (a) Certification.—For purposes of the Defense
- 7 Access Road Program, the roads specified in subsection
- 8 (b) in the vicinity of Beale Air Force Base, California, or

1	in the vicinity of Travis Air Force Base, California, are
2	hereby certified to the Secretary of Defense, and by exten-
3	sion to the Secretary of Transportation, as important to
4	the national defense pursuant to section 210 of title 23,
5	United States Code.
6	(b) ROADS IDENTIFIED.—The certification made by
7	subsection (a) applies to the following roads:
8	(1) For Beale Air Force Base, California:
9	(A) Chuck Yeager Road.
10	(B) North Beale Road.
11	(C) Spenceville Road, also known as Camp
12	Beale Highway.
13	(D) South Beale Road.
14	(2) For Travis Air Force Base, California:
15	(A) Air Base Parkway.
16	(B) Canon Road.
17	(C) Gate Road, including North Gate
18	Road.
19	(D) Petersen Road.
20	(E) Vanden Road.
