- *** Section 1.** AS 23.15.835(d) is amended to read:
- 5 (d) Notwithstanding AS 23.15.840(a), for the fiscal years ending June 30,
- 6 2015, through June 30, 2020 [2017], the money collected under this section or
- otherwise appropriated to the Alaska Workforce Investment Board [, FORMERLY
- 8 KNOWN AS THE ALASKA HUMAN RESOURCE INVESTMENT COUNCIL,]
- 9 shall be allocated directly in the following percentages to the following institutions for
- programs consistent with AS 23.15.820 23.15.850 and capital improvements:
- University of Alaska 45 percent
- Galena Interior Learning Academy 4 percent
- 13 Alaska Technical Center 9 percent
- 14 Alaska Vocational Technical Center 17 percent
