Mr. Marshall introduced the following joint resolution; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to repeal the twenty-third article of amendment to the Constitution of the United States.

- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives
- 2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled
- 3 (two-thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-
- 4 lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-
- 5 stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all
- 6 intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when
- 7 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several
- 8 States within seven years after the date of its submission
- 9 for ratification:

1		"ARTICLE —
2	"Section 1	The twenty-third

- 2 "Section 1. The twenty-third article of amendment
- 3 to the Constitution of the United States is hereby re-
- 4 pealed.
- 5 "Section 2. Congress shall have the power to en-
- 6 force this article by appropriate legislation.".
