- 3 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 4 That:
- 5 (a) The University of Maryland, Baltimore shall study the health effects of air 6 traffic noise on communities near the Baltimore/Washington International Thurgood 7 Marshall (BWI) Airport since the implementation of the Next Generation Air 8 Transportation System (NextGen).
- 9 (b) The study required under subsection (a) of this section shall evaluate:
- 10 (1) health outcomes in communities near BWI Airport before and after the 11 implementation of NextGen, including cardiovascular diseases, generalized anxiety 12 disorder, and other conditions that are reasonably related to air traffic noise;
- 13 (2) costs associated with the health outcomes identified under item (1) of this subsection; and
- 15 (3) cost savings generated due to the implementation of NextGen.
- 16 (c) The Maryland Aviation Administration shall provide any available data requested by the University of Maryland, Baltimore for the completion of the study.
- 18 (d) The University of Maryland, Baltimore may use medical claims data to 19 complete the study.
- 20 (e) The Governor shall include in the fiscal year 2022 budget bill an appropriation of at least \$130,000 \$100,000 for the purpose of carrying out the study required under subsection (a) of this section.
- 23 (f) On or before September 1, 2022, the University of Maryland, Baltimore shall submit a report to the Governor, the County Executive and County Council of Baltimore County, the County Executive and County Council of Howard County, the County
- 26 Executive and County Council of Montgomery County, the County Executive and County
- 27 <u>Council of Prince George's County County Executives and County Councils of Anne Arundel</u>
- 28 County, Baltimore County, Howard County, Montgomery County, and Prince George's

- 31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 32 October 1, 2020.
