A BILL

To redesignate the Saint-Gaudens National Historic Site as the “Saint-Gaudens National Historical Park”, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Saint-Gaudens Na-
5 tional Historical Park Redesignation Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF SAINT-GAUDENS NATIONAL HIS-**
7 **TORICAL PARK.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Saint-Gaudens National His-
9 toric Site shall be known and designated as the “Saint-
10 Gaudens National Historical Park”.

1 (b) AMENDMENTS TO PUBLIC LAW 88–543.—Public
2 Law 88–543 (78 Stat. 749) is amended—

3 (1) by striking “National Historic Site” each
4 place it appears and inserting “National Historical
5 Park”;

6 (2) in section 2(a), by striking “historic site”
7 and inserting “Saint-Gaudens National Historical
8 Park”;

9 (3) in section 3, by—

10 (A) striking “national historical site” and
11 inserting “Saint-Gaudens National Historical
12 Park”; and

13 (B) striking “part of the site” and insert-
14 ing “part of the park”; and

15 (4) in section 4(b), by striking “traditional to
16 the site” and inserting “traditional to the park”.

17 (c) REFERENCES.—Any reference in any law, regula-
18 tion, document, record, map, or other paper of the United
19 States to the Saint-Gaudens National Historic Site shall
20 be considered to be a reference to the “Saint-Gaudens Na-
21 tional Historical Park”.

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
