## A BILL

To prohibit the use of Federal funds to administer a COVID-19 vaccine to officers and employees of the U.S. Border Patrol, U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement, or certain Department of the Interior officers and employees or require that such officers and employees receive such a vaccine as a condition of employment.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

1	SECTION 1. NO VACCINE MANDATE FOR U.S. BORDER PA-
2	TROL, U.S. IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS EN-
3	FORCEMENT, OR CERTAIN DEPARTMENT OF
4	THE INTERIOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES.
5	No Federal funds may be used to—
6	(1) administer a COVID-19 vaccine to—
7	(A) any officer or employee of the U.S.
8	Border Patrol or the U.S. Immigration and
9	Customs Enforcement; or
10	(B) any officer or employee of the Depart-
11	ment of the Interior or the Drug Enforcement
12	Agency who is engaged in activities respecting
13	the construction or maintenance of a border
14	barrier along the souther border of the United
15	States; or
16	(2) require any such officer or employee to re-
17	ceive such a vaccine as a condition of employment.
