A BILL

- To provide that a risk evaluation and mitigation strategy communication plan may include information about Federal and State prescribing requirements for controlled substances.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Reducing Opioid Risk
 - 5 Act".

1	SEC. 2. RISK EVALUATION AND MITIGATION STRATEGY
2	COMMUNICATION PLANS.
3	Section 505–1(e)(3) of the Federal Food, Drug, and
4	Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. 355–1(e)(3)) is amended—
5	(1) in subparagraph (B), by adding a semicolon
6	at the end;
7	(2) in subparagraph (C), by striking "; or" and
8	inserting a semicolon;
9	(3) in subparagraph (D), by striking the period
10	and inserting "; or"; and
11	(4) by adding at the end the following:
12	"(E) disseminating information to health
13	care providers about Federal and State pre-
14	scribing requirements for controlled substances,
15	including the requirements under section 309(f)
16	of the Controlled Substances Act, as applica-
17	ble.".
