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18	Section 1. Section 20-1-304, MCA, is amended to read:
19	"20-1-304. Pupil-instruction-related day. A pupil-instruction-related day is a day of teacher activities
20	devoted to improving the quality of instruction. The activities may include but are not limited to inservice
21	training, attending state meetings of teacher organizations, and conducting parent conferences. The activities
22	may not include attending state meetings of teacher organizations. A maximum of 7 pupil-instruction-related
23	days may be conducted during a school year, with a minimum of 3 of the days for instructional and professional

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"20-4-304. Attendance at instructional and professional development meetings. The trustees of
a school district shall close the schools of the district for the annual instructional and professional development
meetings of teachers' organizations. A teacher may attend instructional and professional development meetings
without loss of salary or attend other appropriate inservice training that may be prescribed by the trustees
without loss of salary. If a teacher does not attend, the teacher may not be paid."
