 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "National Statuary Hall
 - 5 Collection Policy Act".

5	Section 311(a)(2) of the Legislative Branch Appro-
6	priations Act, 2001 (2 U.S.C. 2132(a)(2)) is amended—
7	(1) by striking "and" at the end of subpara-
8	graph (A);
9	(2) by striking the period at the end of sub-
10	paragraph (B) and inserting "; and"; and
11	(3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
12	paragraph:
13	"(C) the request has been approved by not
14	fewer than ² / ₃ of the Members of the House of
15	Representatives and Senators who represent the
16	State.".
