

17 18 19 20	(a) In cooperation with the institutions of higher education in the State, the Commission shall establish and administer a Graduate and Professional Scholarship Program to provide financial assistance to full—time and part—time students in the fields of medicine, dentistry, law, pharmacy, nursing, social work, and veterinary medicine.

26 (2) An institution of higher education that receives a grant under this section shall provide the Commission with an annual audit describing the disposition of the funds.

- 2 (1) Establish guidelines for the awarding of graduate and professional scholarships by the institutions of higher education to the students; and
- 4 (2) Adopt regulations necessary for the implementation of this section.
- 5 (g) Funds for the Maryland Graduate and Professional Scholarship Program shall 6 be as provided in the State budget.
