2 **Gaming – Video Lottery Operation License – Renewal Term**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the period of time by which a video lottery operation licensee
4 must notify the State Lottery and Gaming Control Commission of its intent to
5 reapply for a video lottery operation license; and generally relating to video lottery
6 operation licenses.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – State Government**

2 (c) [One year] **TWO YEARS** before the expiration of the term of a video lottery
3 operation license, the licensee shall file with the Commission a notice of intent to reapply
4 for the license under this subtitle.

5 (d) Within 1 year of the end of the initial 15–year license term, a video lottery
6 operation licensee may reapply for a license that has a license term of 10 years and a license
7 fee to be established by statute.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 October 1, 2017.
