A BILL

To amend the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act to provide funding for American Health Benefit Exchanges navigator programs and outreach and promotional activities.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Affordable Care Act
- 5 Outreach for the Uninsured, Transformative Recruitment,

1	and Enrollment Action for Compassionate Healthcare Act
2	of 2019" or the "ACA OUTREACH Act".
3	SEC. 2. FUNDING AMERICAN HEALTH BENEFIT EXCHANGES
4	NAVIGATOR PROGRAMS AND OUTREACH AND
5	PROMOTIONAL ACTIVITIES.
6	(a) Funding for Navigator Program.—Section
7	1311(i) of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act
8	(42 U.S.C. 18031(i)) is amended by adding at the end
9	the following new paragraph:
10	"(7) Appropriations.—Out of any funds in
11	the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, there is
12	appropriated to the Secretary of Health and Human
13	Services \$100,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2019
14	through 2022 for navigator programs under this
15	subsection.".
16	(b) Federal Exchanges Outreach and Pro-
17	MOTIONAL ACTIVITIES.—Section 1321(c) of the Patient
18	Protection and Affordable Care Act (42 U.S.C. 18041(c))
19	is amended by adding at the end the following new para-
20	graph:
21	"(3) Outreach and promotional activi-
22	TIES.—
23	"(A) In general.—In the case of an Ex-
24	change established or operated by the Secretary
25	pursuant to this subsection, the Secretary may

carry out outreach and promotional activities as necessary and appropriate for the successful operation of such Exchange, including for purposes of informing potential enrollees in qualified health plans offered through the Exchange of the availability of coverage under such plans and financial assistance for coverage under such plans.

- "(B) DIVERSE CONSTITUENCIES.—The Secretary shall carry out any outreach and promotional activities under this paragraph in a manner that reaches diverse constituencies, including minority, rural, and underserved communities; people with disabilities; young adults; and individuals who are likely to be uninsured.
- "(C) Funding.—Out of any funds in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, there is appropriated to the Secretary of Health and Human Services \$100,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2019 through 2022 to carry out this paragraph.".
- (c) STATE GRANTS FOR STATE-RUN EXCHANGES
 OUTREACH AND PROMOTIONAL ACTIVITIES.—Section
 1311 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act

- 1 (42 U.S.C. 18031) is amended by adding at the end the
- 2 following new subsection:
- 3 "(1) STATE-RUN EXCHANGES OUTREACH AND PRO-
- 4 MOTIONAL ACTIVITIES.—
- 5 "(1) In General.—The Secretary shall carry 6 out a grant program under which the Secretary 7 awards grants to States that are electing States 8 under section 1321(b) that have established Ex-9 changes. Each such grant awarded to such a State 10 that has established an Exchange shall be used by 11 such Exchange for purposes of outreach and pro-12 motional activities as necessary and appropriate for 13 the successful operation of the Exchange, including 14 for purposes of informing potential enrollees in 15 qualified health plans offered through the Exchange 16 of the availability of coverage under such plans and 17 financial assistance for coverage under such plans.

"(2) Eligibility.—

"(A) APPLICATION.—To be eligible for a grant under paragraph (1), a State described in such paragraph shall submit an application to the Secretary at such time, in such manner, and containing such information as specified by the Secretary. In establishing the process for States to apply for such grants, the Secretary

shall ensure that applications are processed in a timely manner.

"(B) DIVERSE CONSTITUENCIES.—To be eligible for a grant under paragraph (1), a State described in such paragraph shall provide such assurances as are required by the Secretary to ensure that the Exchange established by such State carries out outreach and promotional activities under such grant in a manner that reaches diverse constituencies, including minority, rural, and underserved communities; people with disabilities; young adults; and individuals who are likely to be uninsured.

"(3) Funding.—Out of any funds in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, there is appropriated to the Secretary of Health and Human Services \$100,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2019 through 2022 to carry out this subsection.".
