A BILL

To prohibit the use of members of the United States Armed Forces to carry out offensive combat operations in Syria.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON USE OF MEMBERS OF THE 4 UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES TO CARRY 5 OUT OFFENSIVE COMBAT OPERATIONS IN 6 SYRIA. 7 The President may not use members of the Armed Forces of the United States to carry out offensive combat 8 operations in Syria unless Congress has enacted a specific

- 1 authorization for such use of members of the Armed
