A BILL

To amend the Mineral Leasing Act to require payment to counties of a portion of certain revenues received by the United States under Federal oil and gas leases, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Providing Opportunity
- 5 With Energy Revenues in Counties Act" or the "POWER
- 6 Counties Act".

1	SEC. 2. PAYMENT TO COUNTIES OF PORTION OF CERTAIN
2	REVENUES RECEIVED BY THE UNITED
3	STATES UNDER FEDERAL OIL AND GAS
4	LEASES.
5	(a) In General.—Section 35(a) of the Mineral
6	Leasing Act (30 U.S.C. 191(a)) is amended—
7	(1) by striking "40 per centum" and inserting
8	"20 per centum"; and
9	(2) by inserting ", and 20 per centum thereof
10	shall be paid to the county within the boundaries of
11	which the leased lands or deposits are or were lo-
12	cated and may be used by such county for its
13	schools and roads" after "June 17, 1902".
14	(b) Conforming Amendment.—Section 35(a) of
15	the Mineral Leasing Act (30 U.S.C. 191(a)) is amended
16	by striking "and the Geothermal Steam Act of 1970,".
