A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Prohibiting Private
5 Sector Vaccine Mandates Act of 2022”.

1 **SEC. 2. OSHA COVID-19 VACCINATION MANDATE.**

2 No funds appropriated, or otherwise made available,
3 may be used to implement, finalize, or otherwise carry out
4 the rule submitted by the Department of Labor relating
5 to “COVID-19 Vaccination and Testing; Emergency
6 Temporary Standard” (86 Fed. Reg. 61402 (November
7 5, 2021)), and such rule shall have no force or effect.

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
