# A BILL

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Prohibiting Private
- 5 Sector Vaccine Mandates Act of 2022".

### 1 SEC. 2. OSHA COVID-19 VACCINATION MANDATE.

- 2 No funds appropriated, or otherwise made available,
- 3 may be used to implement, finalize, or otherwise carry out
- 4 the rule submitted by the Department of Labor relating
- 5 to "COVID-19 Vaccination and Testing; Emergency
- 6 Temporary Standard' (86 Fed. Reg. 61402 (November
- 7 5, 2021)), and such rule shall have no force or effect.
