A BILL

To amend the Natural Gas Act to expedite approval of exports of small volumes of natural gas, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Small Scale LNG Ac-
5 cess Act of 2017”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXPEDITED APPROVAL OF EXPORT OF CERTAIN**
7 **VOLUMES OF NATURAL GAS.**

8 Section 3(c) of the Natural Gas Act (15 U.S.C.
9 717b(c)) is amended—

1 (1) by striking “(c) For purposes of” and in-
 2 serting the following:

3 “(c) EXPEDITED APPLICATION AND APPROVAL
 4 PROCESS.—

5 “(1) FREE TRADE AGREEMENTS IN EFFECT.—
 6 For purposes of”; and

7 (2) by adding at the end the following:

8 “(2) SMALL-SCALE NATURAL GAS EXPORTS.—
 9 For purposes of subsection (a), any application for
 10 the exportation of natural gas in a volume that is
 11 equal to or less than 51,100,000,000 cubic feet per
 12 year of natural gas shall be—

13 “(A) deemed to be consistent with the pub-
 14 lic interest; and

15 “(B) granted without modification or
 16 delay.

17 “(3) EXCLUSIONS.—Paragraphs (1) and (2)
 18 shall not apply to any nation subject to sanctions
 19 imposed by the United States.”.

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
