OFFERED AT AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION;

- 1 (II) OFFERED BY AN ORGANIZATION APPROVED BY THE COUNTY 2 BOARD; AND
- 3 (III) APPROVED BY THE COUNTY BOARD.
- 4 (3) "INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION" HAS THE MEANING 5 STATED IN § 10–101 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 6 (B) BEGINNING IN THE 2026–2027 SCHOOL YEAR, EACH COUNTY BOARD
 7 SHALL ALLOW SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF AN ELIGIBLE FINANCIAL LITERACY
 8 COURSE TO BE APPLIED TOWARD FULFILLMENT OF THE STUDENT SERVICE HOURS
 9 HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENT FOR THE NUMBER OF HOURS
 10 DETERMINED BY THE COUNTY BOARD.
- 11 (C) THE STATE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS 12 SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2025.
