- 3 SECTION 1. APPLICATION OF THE EXPEDITED FUNDS
- 4 AVAILABILITY ACT.
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Expedited Funds Availability
- 6 Act (12 U.S.C. 4001 et seq.) is amended—
- 7 (1) in section 602(20) (12 U.S.C. 4001(20)) by
- 8 inserting ", located in the United States," after
- 9 "ATM";

(2) in section 602(21) (12 U.S.C. 4001(21)) by 1 2 inserting "American Samoa, the Commonwealth of 3 the Northern Mariana Islands," after "Puerto 4 Rico,"; 5 (3) in section 602(23) (12 U.S.C. 4001(23)) by inserting "American Samoa, the Commonwealth of 6 the Northern Mariana Islands," after "Puerto 7 Rico,"; and 8 9 section (4) in 603(d)(2)(A)(12)U.S.C. 4002(d)(2)(A)), by inserting "American Samoa, the 10 Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands," 11 after "Puerto Rico,". 12 (b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by 13 14 this Act shall take effect as if enacted on January 1, 2017.
