A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning 2 Vehicle Laws - Traffic Control Signal Monitoring Systems, Speed Monitoring 3 Systems, and Work Zone Speed Control Systems - Citation Responses 4 FOR the purpose of altering a certain warning on a citation issued for a violation recorded 5 by a traffic control signal monitoring system, a speed monitoring system, or a work 6 zone speed control system to state the number of days within which a person alleged 7 to be liable must take a certain action in order to avoid an automatic admission of 8 liability; and generally relating to citations issued for violations recorded by traffic 9 control signal monitoring systems, speed monitoring systems, or work zone speed control systems. 10 11 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article – Transportation 12 13 Section 21–202.1(a)(1) and (5) and (e)(2) through (5), 21–809(a)(1) and (8) and (d)(2) through (5), and 21–810(a)(6) and (7) 14 15 Annotated Code of Maryland 16 (2012 Replacement Volume and 2019 Supplement) 17 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, 18 Article – Transportation 19 Section 21-202.1(e)(1)(x), 21-809(d)(1)(xi), and 21-810(d)20 Annotated Code of Maryland 21 (2012 Replacement Volume and 2019 Supplement) 22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 23

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- 1 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated. 2 "Traffic control signal monitoring system" means a device with one or (5)3 more motor vehicle sensors working in conjunction with a traffic control signal to produce recorded images of motor vehicles entering an intersection against a red signal indication. 4 5 Subject to the provisions of paragraphs (2) through (4) of this 6 subsection, an agency shall mail to the owner liable under subsection (d) of this section a 7 citation which shall include: 8 (x) Information advising the person alleged to be liable under this 9 section: 10 1. Of the manner and time in which liability as alleged in the citation may be contested in the District Court; and 11 12 2. Warning that failure to pay the civil penalty or to contest liability [in a timely manner] WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OF THE 13 14 CITATION is an admission of liability and may result in refusal or suspension of the motor 15 vehicle registration. The agency may mail a warning notice in lieu of a citation to the owner 16 (2)17 liable under subsection (d) of this section. 18 (3)Except as provided in subsection (g)(5) of this section, a citation issued 19 under this section shall be mailed no later than 2 weeks after the alleged violation. 20 An agency may not mail a citation to a person who is not an owner **(4)** 21under subsection (a)(3)(ii) of this section. 22(5)A person who receives a citation under paragraph (1) of this subsection 23may: 24 Pay the civil penalty, in accordance with instructions on the 25citation, directly to the political subdivision or to the District Court; or 26 (ii) Elect to stand trial for the alleged violation. 27 21 - 809.28 In this section the following words have the meanings indicated. work zone traffic control device, is being performed regardless of whether workers are

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1 "Work zone speed control system" means a device having one or more 2 motor vehicle sensors connected to a camera system capable of producing recorded images 3 of motor vehicles traveling at or above a predetermined speed in or approaching a work 4 zone. 5 (d) Subject to the provisions of paragraphs (2) through (4) of this (1) subsection, a local police department, State police department, or police department 6 7 contractor shall mail to the owner liable under subsection (c) of this section a citation that 8 shall include: 9 (i) The name and address of the registered owner of the vehicle: 10 The registration number of the motor vehicle involved in the (ii) 11 violation; 12 (iii) The violation charged; 13 (iv) The location where the violation occurred; 14 (v) The date and time of the violation; 15 (vi) At least one recorded image of the vehicle with a data bar imprinted on each image that includes the speed of the vehicle and the date and time the 16 17 image was recorded; 18 The amount of the civil penalty imposed and the date by which (vii) the civil penalty should be paid; 19 20 (viii) A signed statement by a police officer employed by the local police 21department or State police department that, based on inspection of recorded images, the 22motor vehicle was being operated in violation of this subtitle; 23A statement that recorded images are evidence of a violation of (ix) this subtitle; 2425(x) Information advising the person alleged to be liable under this 26 section of the manner and time in which liability as alleged in the citation may be contested in the District Court; and 27 28 Information advising the person alleged to be liable under this (xi) 29 section that failure to pay the civil penalty or to contest liability in a [timely manner] 30 WITHIN 60 DAYS: 1.
