A BILL

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Chesapeake Bay Gate-
- 5 ways and Watertrails Network Reauthorization Act of
- 6 2019".

1 SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF CHESAPEAKE BAY GATE-

- 2 WAYS AND WATERTRAILS NETWORK.
- 3 Section 502(2) of the Chesapeake Bay Initiative Act
- 4 of 1998 (16 U.S.C. 461 note; Public Law 105-312) is
- 5 amended by striking "for each of fiscal years 1999
- 6 through 2019" and inserting "for each of fiscal years
- 7 2020 through 2025".
