A BILL

To prohibit the Secretary of the Interior and the Secretary of Agriculture from issuing moratoriums on issuing new oil and gas leases and drill permits on certain Federal lands.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- This Act may be cited as the "Saving America's En-
- 5 ergy Future Act".

SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON MORATORIUMS OF NEW OIL AND
GAS LEASES ON CERTAIN FEDERAL LANDS.
(a) Prohibition.—The Secretary concerned may not
issue a moratorium on issuing new oil and gas leases and
drill permits, nor renewals of such permits, on Federa
lands under such Secretary's jurisdiction.
(b) Definitions.—The term "Secretary concerned"
means—
(1) the Secretary of Agriculture, with respect to
National Forest System lands; and
(2) the Secretary of the Interior, with respect
to public lands administered by such Secretary.
