A BILL

To enact section 5.281 of the Revised Code to 1
designate the first week of May as In-Demand 2
Jobs Week. 3

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5.281 of the Revised Code be 4
enacted to read as follows: 5

Sec. 5.281. Beginning in 2018, and every year thereafter, 6
the full week beginning on the first Monday in May is designated 7
as in-demand jobs week. 8

Every year during in-demand jobs week, the governor's 9
office of workforce transformation, in collaboration with the 10
departments of job and family services, education, and higher 11

<u>education, shall organize activities to raise awareness among</u>	12
<u>educators, students, and parents of jobs that are in demand by</u>	13
<u>employers operating in this state and the requirements and</u>	14
<u>benefits of those jobs. The activities shall include job fairs</u>	15
<u>and company tours to connect middle and high school students</u>	16
<u>with employers.</u>	17
