Ms. Brownley of California introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To authorize the President to award the Medal of Honor to John L. Canley for acts of valor during the Vietnam War while a member of the Marine Corps.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION FOR AWARD OF MEDAL OF
- 4 HONOR TO JOHN L. CANLEY FOR ACTS OF
- 5 VALOR DURING THE VIETNAM WAR.
- 6 (a) Waiver of Time Limitations.—Notwith-
- 7 standing the time limitations specified in section 6248 of
- 8 title 10, United States Code, or any other time limitation
- 9 with respect to the awarding of certain medals to persons

- 1 who served in the Armed Forces, the President may award
- 2 the Medal of Honor under section 6241 of such title to
- 3 John L. Canley for the acts of valor during the Vietnam
- 4 War described in subsection (b).
- 5 (b) Acts of Valor Described.—The acts of valor
- 6 referred to in subsection (a) are the actions of then Gun-
- 7 nery Sergeant John L. Canley during combat operations
- 8 from January 31, 1968, to February 6, 1968, during the
- 9 Vietnam War as a member of the Marine Corps, for which
- 10 he was previously awarded the Navy Cross.
