l	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 13-B MRSA §701-A is enacted to read:
3	§701-A. Board of directors of a nonprofit housing corporation
4 5	A corporation organized under this Title that enters into a rental agreement for dwelling units in a multi-unit residential building shall include on its board of directors a current
6 7	tenant of that building. This section does not apply to a corporation that only provides emergency shelter or short-term transitional housing. For purposes of this section,
8	"dwelling unit" has the same meaning as in Title 14, section 6021, subsection 1.
9	SUMMARY
10	This bill requires a nonprofit corporation that provides dwelling units in a multi-unit
11 12 13	residential building to include a current tenant on its board of directors. It does not apply to a nonprofit corporation that only provides emergency shelter or short-term transitional bousing
13	housing.
