Military Force.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROSPECTIVE REPEAL OF 2001 AUTHORIZA-**
4 **TION FOR USE OF MILITARY FORCE.**

5 Effective on the date that is one year after the date
6 of the enactment of this joint resolution, the Authorization
7 for Use of Military Force (Public Law 107–40; 115 Stat.
8 224; 50 U.S.C. 1541 note) is repealed.
