To prohibit the use of Federal funds for payments in support of campaigns for election for the offices of Senator or Representative in Congress.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITING USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS FOR
- 4 PAYMENTS IN SUPPORT OF CONGRESSIONAL
- 5 CAMPAIGNS.
- 6 No Federal funds may be used to make any payment
- 7 in support of a campaign for election for the office of Sen-
- 8 ator or Representative in, or Delegate or Resident Com-
- 9 missioner to, the Congress.
