Mr. Obernolte introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to establish, within the National Park Service, the Japanese American World War II History Network, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Japanese American
- 5 World War II History Network Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. JAPANESE AMERICAN WORLD WAR II HISTORY NET-
- 7 work.
- 8 (a) Establishment.—The Secretary of the Interior
- 9 (hereinafter referred to as the "Secretary") shall estab-

- lish, within the National Park Service, a program to be
 known as the "Japanese American World War II History
 Network" (hereinafter referred to as the "Network").
 (b) Duties of Secretary.—In carrying out the
 Network, the Secretary shall—
 (1) review studies and reports to complement
- (1) review studies and reports to complement and not duplicate studies of Japanese American World War II history and Japanese American experiences during World War II, including studies related to relocation centers and confinement sites, that are underway or completed;
 - (2) produce and disseminate appropriate educational materials, such as handbooks, maps, interpretive guides, or electronic information relating to Japanese American World War II history and Japanese American experiences during the war, including relocation centers and confinement sites;
 - (3) enter into appropriate cooperative agreements and memoranda of understanding to provide technical assistance under subsection (c); and
 - (4)(A) create and adopt an official, uniform symbol or device for the Network; and
- 23 (B) issue regulations for the use of the symbol or device adopted under subparagraph (A).

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1	(c) Elements.—The Network shall encompass the
2	following elements:
3	(1) All units and programs of the National
4	Park Service that are determined by the Secretary
5	to relate to Japanese American World War II his-
6	tory and Japanese American experiences during the
7	war, including relocation centers and confinement
8	sites.
9	(2) With the consent of the property owner,
10	other Federal, State, local, Tribal, and privately
11	owned properties that—
12	(A) relate to Japanese American World
13	War II history and Japanese experiences during
14	the war, including relocation centers and con-
15	finement sites;
16	(B) have a verifiable connection to Japa-
17	nese American World War II history and Japa-
18	nese experiences during the war, including relo-
19	cation and confinement sites; and
20	(C) are included in, or determined by the
21	Secretary to be eligible for inclusion in, the Na-
22	tional Register of Historic Places.
23	(3) Other governmental and nongovernmental
24	facilities and programs of an educational, research,
25	or interpretive nature that are directly related to

- 1 Japanese American World War II history and the
- 2 experiences of Japanese Americans during the war,
- 3 including relocation centers and confinement sites.

4 SEC. 3. COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS AND MEMORANDA OF

5 UNDERSTANDING.

- To achieve the purposes of this Act and to ensure
- 7 effective coordination of the Federal and non-Federal ele-
- 8 ments of the Network described in section 2(c) with units
- 9 of the National Park System and programs of the Na-
- 10 tional Park Service, including the Japanese American
- 11 Confinement Sites Program, the Secretary may enter into
- 12 cooperative agreements and memoranda of understanding
- 13 with, and provide technical assistance to the heads of
- 14 other Federal agencies, States, units of local government,
- 15 Tribes, regional governmental bodies, and private entities.
- 16 SEC. 4. SUNSET.
- 17 The authority of the Secretary under this Act shall
- 18 expire 7 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
