BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Business Regulation Section 7–502 Annotated Code of Maryland (2015 Replacement Volume and 2020 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article – Business Regulation** 7-502.Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act, this title and all regulations adopted under this title shall terminate on July 1, [2022] **2032**.
