- 5 (a) Reliquidation of Entries.—Section 205(a)(1)
- 6 of the United States-Mexico-Canada Agreement Imple-
- 7 mentation Act (Public Law 116–113) is amended by strik-
- 8 ing subparagraph (C) and inserting the following:

1	"(C) by striking 'for which' and inserting
2	', or section 202 of the United States-Mexico-
3	Canada Agreement Implementation Act, for
4	which'; and''.
5	(b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
6	subsection (a) shall take effect as if included in the enact-
7	ment of the United States-Mexico-Canada Agreement Im-
