1 **A LEGISLATIVE COMMEMORATION, Celebrating the wrestling career of Jackson**
2 **Remmers.**

3 WHEREAS, Jackson Remmers began his wrestling career at McCook Central High School
4 and placed sixth in the 106-pound weight class at the State B wrestling tournament as a
5 seventh grader in 2019; and

6 WHEREAS, as an eighth grader, Jackson placed fourth in the 126-pound weight class at
7 the State B wrestling tournament in 2020; and

8 WHEREAS, as a freshman, Jackson was the 132-pound weight class state champion at the
9 State B wrestling tournament in 2021; and

10 WHEREAS, as a sophomore, Jackson finished the season as the runner-up in the 145-
11 pound weight class at the State B wrestling tournament in 2022; and

12 WHEREAS, as a junior, Jackson completed an undefeated season, earning his second state
13 title as the 152-pound weight class state champion at the 2023 State B wrestling tournament;
14 and

15 WHEREAS, Jackson transferred to Howard High School for his senior year and continued
16 his dominance on the mat, completing a second consecutive undefeated season and earning
17 his third state title as the 157-pound weight class state champion at the 2024 State B
18 wrestling tournament; and

19 WHEREAS, Jackson completed his high school wrestling career with one hundred and one
20 consecutive wins and tied the all-time state record with two hundred and eighty-six total
21 career wins;

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT COMMEMORATED, by the Ninety-Ninth Legislature of the State
23 of South Dakota, that Jackson Remmers is one of the most outstanding wrestlers in the history
