- 1 (F) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1 EACH YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL 2 REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1257 OF THE 3 STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 4 (1) THE NUMBER OF INSTANCES IN WHICH A DISPOSABLE BAG WAS
 5 USED TO TRANSPORT THE PERSONAL BELONGINGS OF A CHILD IN FOSTER CARE AND
 6 THE REASON THE DEPARTMENT FAILED TO PROVIDE THE CHILD IN FOSTER CARE
 7 WITH NEW LUGGAGE; AND
- 8 (2) THE DEPARTMENT'S SUPPLY INVENTORY AND INVENTORY
 9 MANAGEMENT PROCEDURES FOR THE NEW LUGGAGE SUPPLY MAINTAINED UNDER
 10 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 October 1, 2024.
