## A BILL

To repeal section 138 of the Clean Air Act, relating to environmental and climate justice block grants.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Ending Green Give-
- 5 aways Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. REPEAL AND RESCISSION RELATING TO ENVIRON-
- 7 MENTAL AND CLIMATE JUSTICE BLOCK
- 8 GRANTS.
- 9 (a) Repeal.—Section 138 of the Clean Air Act (42)
- 10 U.S.C. 7438) is repealed.

- 1 (b) Rescission.—The unobligated balance of any
- 2 amounts made available under section 138 of the Clean
- 3 Air Act (42 U.S.C. 7438) (as in effect on the day before

4 the date of enactment of this Act) is rescinded.
