A BILL

To amend the National Trails System Act to extend the Lewis and Clark National Historic Trail, and for other purposes.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Eastern Legacy Exten-
5	sion Act".
6	SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF LEWIS AND CLARK NATIONAL HIS
7	TORIC TRAIL.
8	(a) Extension.—Section 5(a)(6) of the National
9	Trails System Act (16 U.S.C. 1244(a)(6)) is amended—
10	(1) by striking "three thousand seven hundred"
11	and inserting "4,900";
12	(2) by striking "Wood River, Illinois," and in-
13	serting "the Ohio River in Pittsburgh, Pennsyl-
14	vania,"; and
15	(3) by striking "maps identified as, Vicinity
16	Map, Lewis and Clark Trail' study report dated
17	April 1977." and inserting "the map entitled Lewis
18	and Clark National Historic Trail Authorized Trail
19	Including Proposed Eastern Legacy Extension, dated
20	April 2018, and numbered 648/143721."
21	(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by sub-
22	section (a) shall take effect on the date that is 60 days after
23	the date of the enactment of this Act.
