19		form as the department may require. Every motor carrier vehicle license shall be
20		renewed annually.
21	(3)	(a) Except <u>for driveaway plates issued under Section 1 of this Act, and except</u> as
22		permitted under paragraph (b) of this subsection, an applicant or license
23		holder shall pay to the department the following annual license fees:
24		1. Thirty dollars (\$30) for each taxicab, limousine, TNC, or disabled

1 (6) All cities or counties of the Commonwealth may impose an annual license fee on an 2 intrastate taxicab, limousine, or disabled persons vehicle operated from said city or 3 county. The annual license fee shall not exceed thirty dollars (\$30) per vehicle.

- Notwithstanding any other provisions of this section, nonresident motor carriers engaged in transporting passengers for hire in irregular route interstate charter or special operations shall be exempt from all fees prescribed in this chapter, if reciprocal privileges are granted to similar nonresident carriers by the laws and regulations of his or her state.
- 9 (8) If any person required to pay a license fee under subsection (3) of this section 10 begins the operation of an additional motor carrier vehicle after the date of its 11 certificate or renewal, the fee shall be as many twelfths of the annual fee as there 12 are unexpired months in the certificate or renewal year.
- 13 (9) The department may promulgate administrative regulations <u>in accordance with</u>
 14 <u>KRS Chapter 13A</u> as it deems necessary to <u>administer this section[carry out]</u>.
