- WHEREAS, Angelman syndrome is a rare, neurogenetic disorder that affects
- 4 chromosome 15, resulting in intellectual and developmental delay; and
- 5 WHEREAS, about 1 in 20,000 people in the United States are affected by
- 6 Angelman syndrome; and
- WHEREAS, Angelman syndrome is a complex genetic disorder that primarily
- 8 affects the nervous system; and
- 9 WHEREAS, February is International Rare Disease Month; and
- WHEREAS, the purpose of Angelman Syndrome Awareness Day is to raise
- awareness of this condition, mobilize people to action, encourage fundraising, promote
- 12 research and educational resources, and remember those affected with Angelman
- 13 syndrome; and
- 14 WHEREAS, with early identification and treatment, medical, sleep, seizure, and
- developmental issues associated with Angelman syndrome may be managed; and
- WHEREAS, the Angelman Syndrome Foundation provides advocacy, education,
- support, and access to resources for parents and researchers around the world;
