A BILL

To prohibit Federal funds from being used to develop, implement, support, or endorse vaccine passports.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Protecting Americans
- 5 Safety, Security, and Privacy Over Repressive Tyranny
- 6 Act" or the "Passport Act".

1	SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON USING FEDERAL FUNDS FOR DE-
2	VELOPING, IMPLEMENTING, SUPPORTING, OR
3	ENDORSING VACCINE PASSPORTS.
4	No Federal funds may be used to develop, implement,
5	support, or endorse a system under which an individual
6	is required to provide documentation that shows the vac-
7	cination status of the individual in order for that indi-
8	vidual to conduct an activity, including to travel or attend
9	an event.
