- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Training and Nutrition
- 5 Stability Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO THE SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION
- 7 ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.
- 8 Section 5 of the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 (7
- 9 U.S.C. 2014) is amended by striking subsection (l).

SEC. 3.
