A BILL

To amend the Water Resources Reform and Development Act of 2014 with respect to the application of the Spill Prevention, Control, and Countermeasure rule to certain farms, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Farmers Undertake
5 Environmental Land Stewardship Act” or the “FUELS
6 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. APPLICABILITY OF SPILL PREVENTION, CONTROL,**
 2 **AND COUNTERMEASURE RULE.**

3 Section 1049 of the Water Resources Reform and De-
 4 velopment Act of 2014 (33 U.S.C. 1361 note; 128 Stat.
 5 1257; 130 Stat. 1902) is amended—

6 (1) in subsection (b)—

7 (A) in paragraph (1)(B), by striking
 8 “20,000” and inserting “42,000”;

9 (B) in paragraph (2), by striking subpara-
 10 graph (A) and inserting the following:

11 “(A) an aggregate aboveground storage ca-
 12 pacity greater than 10,000 gallons but less than
 13 42,000 gallons; and”;

14 (C) in paragraph (3)—

15 (i) by striking subparagraph (A) and
 16 inserting the following:

17 “(A) with an aggregate aboveground stor-
 18 age capacity of less than or equal to 10,000
 19 gallons; and”; and

20 (ii) in subparagraph (B), by striking
 21 “; and” and inserting a period; and

22 (D) by striking paragraph (4);

23 (2) in subsection (c)(2)(A)—

24 (A) in clause (i), by striking “1,000” and
 25 inserting “1,320”; and

- 1 (B) in clause (ii), by striking “2,500” and
- 2 inserting “3,000”; and
- 3 (3) by striking subsection (d).
