- To amend the Disaster Recovery Reform Act of 2018 to require the Administrator of the Federal Emergency Management Agency to waive certain debts owed to the United States related to covered assistance provided to an individual or household, and for other purposes.

### 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2	This Act may be cited as the "Preventing Disaster				
3	Revictimization Act".				
4	SEC. 2. FLEXIBILITY.				
5	Section 1216(a) of the Disaster Recovery Reform Act				
6	of 2018 (42 U.S.C. 5174a(a)) is amended—				
7	(1) by amending paragraph (2)(A) to read as				
8	follows:				
9	"(A) except as provided in subparagraph				
10	(B), shall—				
11	"(i) waive a debt owed to the United				
12	States related to covered assistance pro-				
13	vided to an individual or household if the				
14	covered assistance was distributed based				
15	on an error by the Agency and such debt				
16	shall be construed as a hardship; and				
17	"(ii) waive a debt owed to the United				
18	States related to covered assistance pro-				
19	vided to an individual or household if such				
20	assistance is subject to a claim or legal ac-				
21	tion, including in accordance with section				
22	317 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Re-				
23	lief and Emergency Assistance Act (42				
24	U.S.C. 5160); and"; and				
25	(2) in paragraph (3)(B)—				

1 (A) by striking "Removal of" and insert-2 ing "Report on"; and

(B) in clause (ii) by striking "the authority of the Administrator to waive debt under paragraph (2) shall no longer be effective" and inserting "the Administrator shall report to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the House of Representatives and the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs of the Senate actions that the Administrator will take to reduce the error rate".

14 The Administrator of the Federal Emergency Man-15 agement Agency shall submit to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the House of Representa-16 tives and the Committee on Homeland Security and Gov-18 ernmental Affairs of the Senate a report containing a de-19 scription of the internal processes used to make decisions regarding the distribution of covered assistance under sec-21 tion 1216 of the Disaster Recovery and Reform Act of 2018 (42 U.S.C. 5174a) and any changes made to such 23 processes.
