1	A RESOLUTION honoring the Transylvania University women's basketball team
2	2023 National Collegiate Athletic Association Division III National Champions and 2024
3	Final Four participants.
4	WHEREAS, on April 1, 2023, at the American Airlines Center in Dallas, Texas, the
5	Transylvania University Pioneers defeated the Captains of Christopher Newport
6	University by a score of 57 to 52 to win the 2023 National Collegiate Athletic
7	Association (NCAA) Division III Women's Basketball championship; and
8	WHEREAS, the Pioneers trailed the number-one-ranked and previously unbeater
9	Captains by as many as nine points in the first quarter, but turned up the defensive energy
10	with great success to lead by two points at halftime, allowing Christopher Newport to
11	score only six points in the second quarter and forcing 13 first-half turnovers; and
12	WHEREAS, Transylvania began the second half on a 13-2 scoring run and built a
13	lead as large as 13 points. The Captains slowly chipped away at that advantage though
14	and the game was twice tied inside the final three minutes, until a Dasia Thornton layur
15	with 43 seconds remaining broke a 49-49 tie; and
16	WHEREAS, playing prominent roles in the 2023 championship game win were
17	senior guard Madison Kellione, who scored 17 points and had seven rebounds; senior
18	forward Dasia Thornton, who posted a double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds
19	and senior guard Kennedi Stacy, who had eight points, 11 rebounds, and eight steals; and
20	WHEREAS, the national championship, the first in the history of the school in any
21	sport, capped off a perfect 33-0 season for the Pioneers; and
22	WHEREAS, in 2024, the Pioneers were again in the spotlight, winning their first 31
23	games before falling to eventual national champion New York University in the Fina
24	Four; and
25	WHEREAS, these results, combined with the Pioneers' Elite Eight appearance in
26	2022, have solidified Transylvania as a force to be reckoned with in the sport, with a
27	record of 130 wins against only 11 losses in the last five seasons, as well as six
