1 AN ACT concerning

2 Baltimore City – Property Tax Credit – Rental Discount for Baltimore City 3 Police Public Safety Officers

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City to grant, by 5 law, a certain property tax credit against the property tax imposed on certain 6 apartment buildings rental dwellings in Baltimore City; establishing that certain 7 landlords that provide certain rental discounts to certain police public safety officers 8 may be eligible for the tax credit; establishing the amount of the tax credit; providing 9 that certain landlords who receive a credit under this Act are ineligible to receive 10 certain other credits against the county property tax under certain circumstances; 11 authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City to establish, by law, the 12 amount and duration of the credit and certain other provisions relating to the tax 13 credit; providing for the application of this Act; providing for the termination of this Act; defining certain terms; and generally relating to a property tax credit in 14 Baltimore City for rental discounts provided to police public safety officers in 15 Baltimore City. 16
