

1 AN ACT relating to public holidays.

2 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

3 ➔Section 1. KRS 2.110 is amended to read as follows:

- 4 (1) The first day of January (New Year's Day), the third Monday of January (Birthday
5 of Martin Luther King, Jr.),~~the nineteenth day of January (Robert E. Lee Day), the~~
6 ~~thirtieth day of January (Franklin D. Roosevelt Day)~~, the twelfth day of February
7 (Lincoln's Birthday), the third Monday in February (Washington's Birthday), the last
8 Monday in May (Memorial Day)~~, the third day of June (Confederate Memorial~~
9 ~~Day, and Jefferson Davis Day)~~, the fourth day of July (Independence Day), **the**
10 **twenty-sixth day of August (Women's Equality Day)**, the first Monday in
11 September (Labor Day), the second Monday in October (**Indigenous People's**
12 ~~{Columbus}~~ Day), the eleventh day of November (Veterans Day), the twenty-fifth
13 day of December (Christmas Day) of each year, and all days appointed by the
14 President of the United States or by the Governor as days of thanksgiving, are
15 holidays, on which all the public offices of this Commonwealth may be closed.
- 16 (2) No person shall be compelled to labor on the first Monday in September (Labor
17 Day) by any person.
