- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to establish an early childhood education pilot program and
- 2 to make an appropriation therefor.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 5 There is hereby established the early childhood education pilot program in the Department
- 6 of Education for the purpose of supporting pre-kindergarten programs. For the purposes of this
- 7 program, an eligible student is:
- 8 (1) A child who is three or four years of age; and
- 9 (2) A child who is not participating in the head start program.
- 10 Section 2. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 11 The secretary of the Department of Education shall select schools to participate in the pilot
- program established in section 1 of this Act among schools that apply for consideration. The
- secretary of the Department of Education shall promulgate rules, pursuant to chapter 1-26,
- establishing the application process and timeline. A participating school shall receive an

allotment of two thousand five hundred dollars for each eligible student enrolled in a pre-

- 2 kindergarten program administered by the school. The Department of Education shall consider
- 3 the following criteria when selecting schools to participate in the program:
- 4 (1) If the pre-kindergarten program is taught by individuals with a birth through
- 5 preschool education endorsement;
- 6 (2) If other public pre-kindergarten or head start services are available in the community;
- 7 and
- 8 (3) If the pre-kindergarten program follows the South Dakota early learning guidelines.
- 9 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of five million dollars
- 10 (\$5,000,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Department of Education for the
- 11 early childhood education pilot program.
- Section 4. The secretary of the Department of Education shall approve vouchers and the
- state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.
- Section 5. Any amounts appropriated in the Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
- revert in accordance with procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.
