A BILL

Making continuing appropriations for fiscal year 2018, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 101. The Continuing Appropriations Act, 4 2018 (division D of Public Law 115–56) is amended— 5 (1) by striking the date specified in section 106(3) and inserting "January 23, 2018"; and 6 7 (2) by adding after section 147 the following: 8 "Sec. 148. Funds appropriated by the Department of Defense Missile Defeat and Defense Enhancements Ap-

- 1 propriations Act, 2018 (division B of Public Law 115–
- 2 96) may be obligated and expended notwithstanding sec-
- 3 tion 504(a)(1) of the National Security Act of 1947 (50
- 4 U.S.C. 3094(a)(1)).
- 5 "Sec. 149. Amounts made available by section 101
- 6 for 'Department of Agriculture—Food and Nutrition
- 7 Service—Child Nutrition Programs' to carry out section
- 8 749(g) of the Agriculture Appropriations Act of 2010
- 9 (Public Law 111–80) may be apportioned up to the rate
- 10 for operations necessary to ensure that the program can
- 11 be fully operational by May 2018.
- "Sec. 150. Amounts made available by section 101
- 13 for 'National Aeronautics and Space Administration—Ex-
- 14 ploration' may be apportioned up to the rate for oper-
- 15 ations necessary to maintain the planned launch capability
- 16 schedules for the Space Launch System launch vehicle,
- 17 Exploration Ground Systems, and Orion Multi-Purpose
- 18 Crew Vehicle programs.
- 19 "Sec. 151. Amounts made available by section 101
- 20 for 'Department of Energy—Energy Programs—Office of
- 21 the Inspector General' may be apportioned up to the rate
- 22 for operations necessary to sustain staffing levels achieved
- 23 on June 30, 2017.
- "Sec. 152. Amounts made available by section 101
- 25 for 'Small Business Administration—Business Loans Pro-

- 1 gram Account' may be apportioned up to the rate for oper-
- 2 ations necessary to accommodate increased demand for
- 3 commitments for general business loans authorized under
- 4 section 7(a) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 636(a)).
- 5 "Sec. 153. For an additional amount for the 'Small
- 6 Business Administration—Disaster Loans Program Ac-
- 7 count' for the cost of direct loans authorized by section
- 8 7(b) of the Small Business Act, \$160,000,000, to remain
- 9 available until expended: *Provided*, That such amount is
- 10 designated by the Congress as an emergency requirement
- 11 pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budg-
- 12 et and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985: Provided
- 13 further, That the amount designated under this heading
- 14 as an emergency requirement pursuant to section
- 15 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency
- 16 Deficit Control Act of 1985 shall be available only if the
- 17 President subsequently so designates such amount and
- 18 transmits such designation to the Congress.
- 19 "Sec. 154. For 2018, the Secretary of Housing and
- 20 Urban Development may make temporary adjustments to
- 21 the Section 8 housing choice voucher annual renewal fund-
- 22 ing allocations and administrative fee eligibility determina-
- 23 tions for public housing agencies in an area for which the
- 24 President declared a disaster in 2017 or 2018 under title
- 25 IV of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emer-

- 1 gency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5170 et seq.), to avoid
- 2 significant adverse funding impacts that would otherwise
- 3 result from the disaster and that would otherwise prevent
- 4 a public housing agency from leasing up to its authorized
- 5 level of units under contract (but not to exceed such level),
- 6 upon request by and in consultation with a public housing
- 7 agency and supported by documentation as required by
- 8 the Secretary that demonstrates the need for the adjust-
- 9 ment.".
- 10 Sec. 102. The Further Additional Continuing Appro-
- 11 priations Act, 2018 (division A of Public Law 115–96)
- 12 is amended by striking section 1002.
- 13 This Act may be cited as the "End The Shutdown
- 14 Act of 2018".
