A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to clarify presumptions of service-connection relating to the exposure to herbicides of certain veterans who served in the Armed Forces during the Vietnam Era, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Fighting for Orange-
- 5 Stricken Territories in the Eastern Region Act".

1	SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION OF PRESUMPTIONS OF SERVICE-
2	CONNECTION FOR VETERANS EXPOSED TO
3	CERTAIN HERBICIDES WHILE SERVING IN
4	THE ARMED FORCES DURING THE VIETNAM
5	ERA.
6	(a) Compensation.—Section 1116 of title 38,
7	United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the
8	following new subsection:
9	"(g) In this section, the term 'Republic of Vietnam'
10	includes each of the following:
11	"(1) The territorial seas of the Republic of
12	Vietnam.
13	"(2) Guam.
14	"(3) The Northern Mariana Islands.
15	"(4) American Samoa.".
16	(b) HEALTH CARE.—Section 1710(e)(4) of such title
17	is amended—
18	(1) by striking "subsection—" and inserting
19	"subsection:"; and
20	(2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
21	paragraph:
22	"(C) The term 'Republic of Vietnam' has the
23	meaning given such term in section 1116(g) of this
24	title.".

- 1 (c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 2 subsections (a) and (b) shall take effect as of September

3 25, 1985.
