## A BILL

  - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
  - This Act may be cited as the "Downwinders Com-
  - 5 pensation Act of 2019".

2	COMPENSATION ACT.
3	Section 4(b)(1) of the Radiation Exposure Com-
4	pensation Act (42 U.S.C. 2210 note; Public Law 101–
5	426) is amended—
6	(1) in subparagraph (B)—
7	(A) by striking "that portion of"; and
8	(B) by striking "that consists of townships
9	13 through 16 at ranges 63 through 71"; and
10	(2) in subparagraph (C), by inserting "all acre-
11	age in any county all or part of which is located in"
12	before "that part".
