BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article – Family Law Section 2-410(a)(1) and (b) Annotated Code of Maryland (2019 Replacement Volume and 2021 Supplement) BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article - Family Law Section 2-410(a)(2) and (5) Annotated Code of Maryland (2019 Replacement Volume and 2021 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Family Law 2-410.

- 1 (a) (1) Except as provided in this subsection, a judge, clerk, or deputy clerk 2 may not receive any fee, remuneration, or gift for performing a marriage ceremony.
- 3 (2) (i) 1. A Maryland judge's fee for performing a marriage 4 ceremony is a nonrefundable fee, payable to the clerk before a marriage license is issued, 5 in the amount of \$30 in Cecil County and \$25 in any other county.
- 6 2. The clerk's or deputy clerk's fee for performing a marriage 7 ceremony is \$30 in Cecil County and \$25 in any other county.
- 8 (ii) Except as provided in [paragraph] PARAGRAPHS (5) AND (10) 9 of this subsection, each month the clerk shall pay \$10 of each fee collected under this section 10 into the general fund of the county.
- 11 (iii) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the clerk shall 12 retain the remainder of each fee and deposit and disburse it in the same manner as other 13 fees collected by the clerk.
- 14 (5) (i) In Baltimore County, the clerk shall pay the [remaining \$15] 15 ENTIRE \$25 FEE to the Baltimore County Historical Trust, Inc.
- 16 (ii) The Baltimore County Historical Trust, Inc. shall report 17 annually to the Baltimore County Executive and the Maryland Historical Trust on the use 18 of all funds received under this section, including a detailed record of the expenditures and 19 receipts of all funds collected before July 1, 1987.
- 20 (iii) The Baltimore County Executive or the Maryland Historical 21 Trust may request at any time an audit of the financial records of the Baltimore County 22 Historical Trust, Inc.
- 23 (b) (1) A clerk or deputy clerk may not violate any provision of this section.
- 24 (2) A clerk or deputy clerk who violates the provisions of this section is 25 guilty of neglect of duty and on conviction is subject to removal from office.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2022.
