## A BILL

To provide that certain project works on the St. Croix River, Maine, are not required to be licensed by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. FEDERAL POWER ACT LICENSE NOT REQUIRED
- 4 FOR CERTAIN PROJECT WORKS ON THE ST.
- 5 CROIX RIVER, MAINE.
- 6 Any project works in existence as of the date of enact-
- 7 ment of this Act, or as may later be modified, that are
- 8 licensed by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission
- 9 under Commission Project numbers 2492, 2618, and
- 10 2660, as in effect on such date of enactment, shall not

- 1 be required to be licensed under part I of the Federal
- $2\,\,$  Power Act (16 U.S.C. 792 et seq.).
